Rake: Raking removes

mold and other diseases.

Weed: Until the first major frost.

Reseed: Repair bare patches with new seed.

Fertilize: Keep your lawn healthy with fertilizer. Choose a fertilizer consistent with your grass type and do not over-fertilize.
